Denise Carvalho

is Secretary of Higher Education at the Brazilian Ministry of Education. She is professor at UFRJ Carlos Chagas Filho Biophysics Institute, and was the first female president of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRJ) (2019-2023). She was also representative of Latin America on the Steering Committee of the Talloires Network of Engaged Universities, regional vicepresident of the Inter-American Organization for Higher Education, vice-president of the Regional Conference of Rectors of Latin American Universities and President of the Group for International Cooperation of Brazilian Universities. She has won several awards, such as the Senior Award from the Latin American Thyroid Society (2010) and the Makes a Difference, from the newspaper O Globo.



Rui Oppermann

is responsible for International Relations at the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel (CAPES), Ministry of Education in Brazil. He is past President of the Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul (UFRGS) (2016-2020). He is a professor at the Graduate Program in Dentistry - Periodontics at UFRGS. He collaborated in the organization of the Latin American and Caribbean Space of Higher Education (ENLACES) and coordinated the participation of Brazilian Public Institutions of Higher Education in the Regional Conference on Higher Education in Latin America and the Caribbean CRES 2018.










