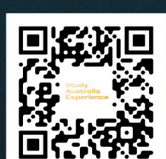

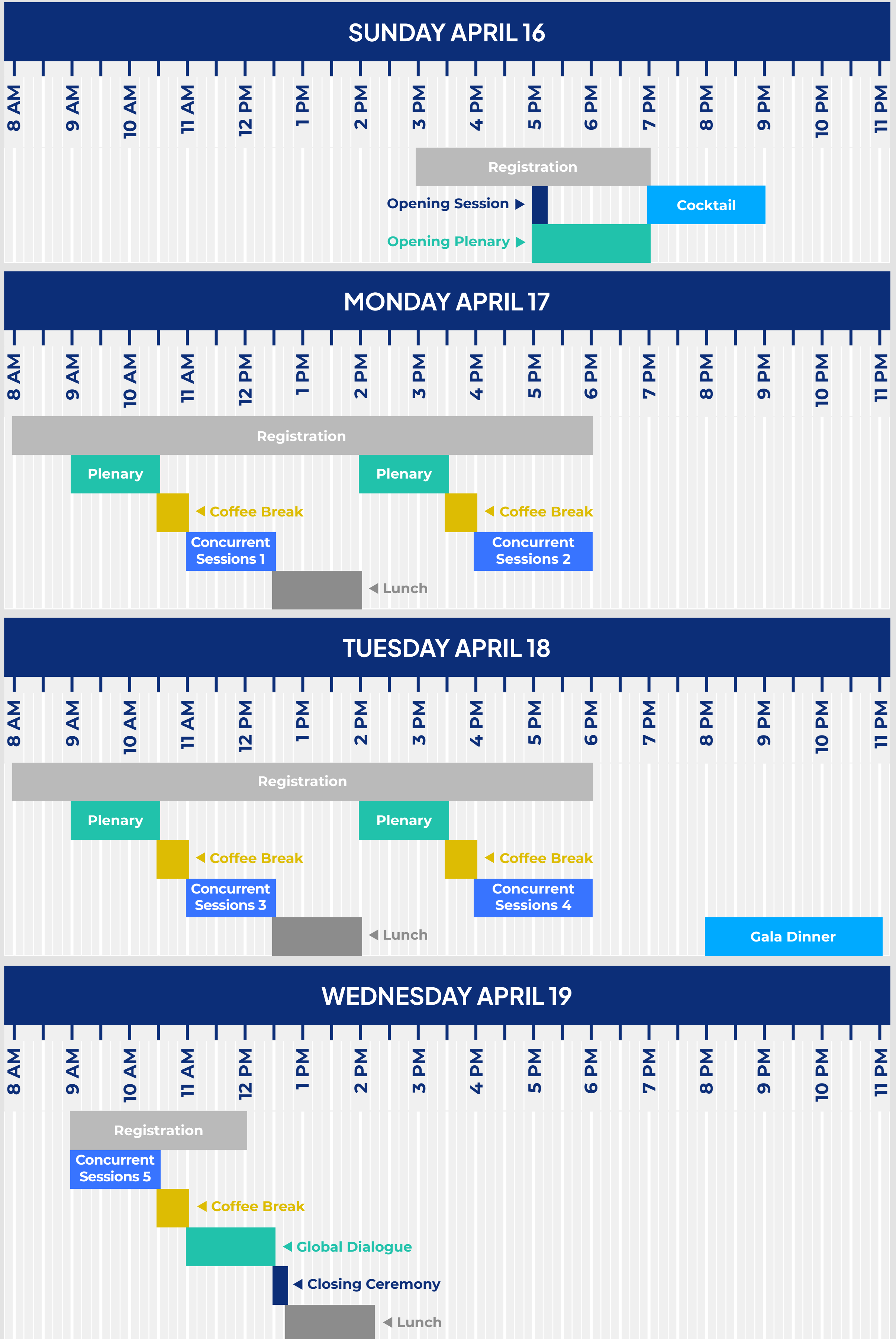

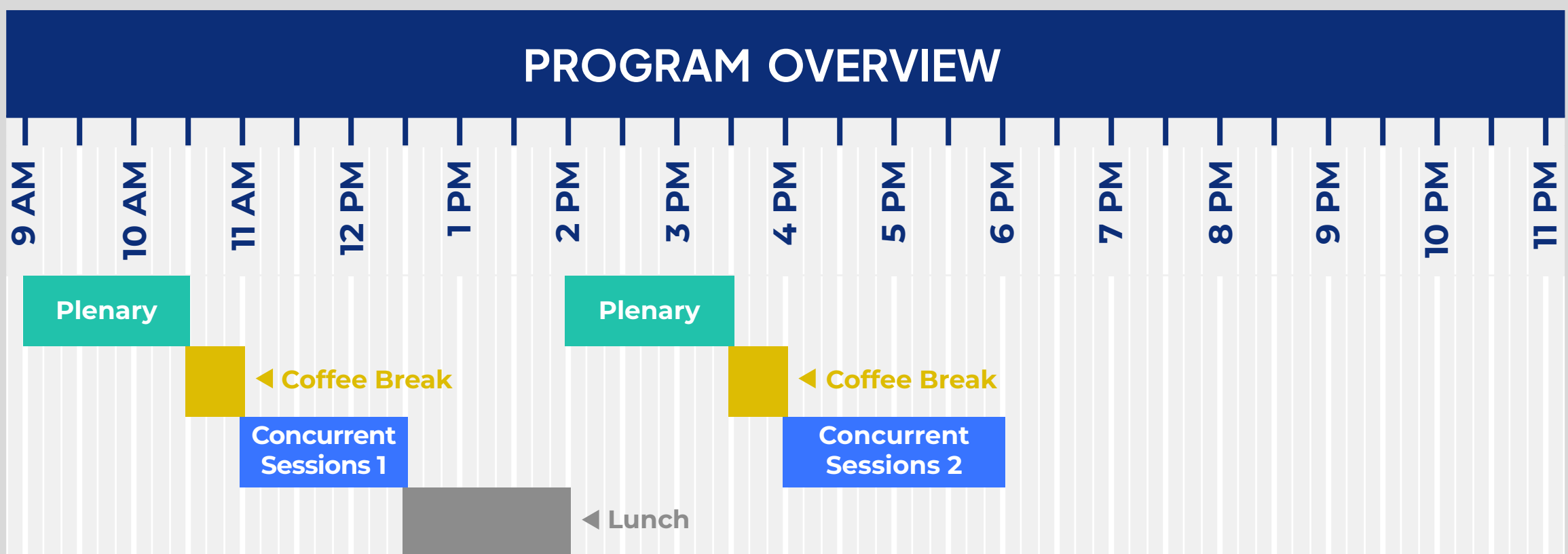
Bianca Santana

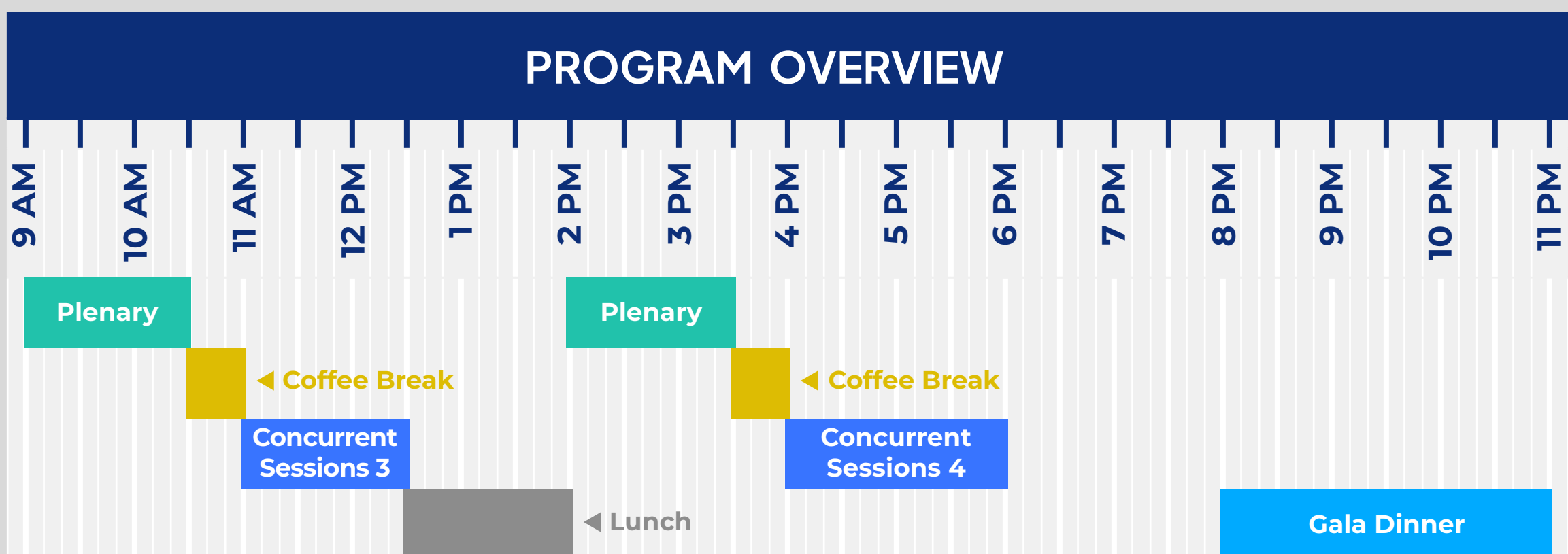

is a specialist in international technical cooperation. She developed a large part of her career in the public sector, particularly in the field of international educational cooperation. She has experience in design, management, and evaluation of science, technology, and innovation projects financed by international agencies and organizations. She is teacher-researcher and responsible for International Relations Management at Universidad Nacional de San Martín - UNSAM (Argentina). She is the author of publications and has given numerous conferences in Argentina and abroad on international cooperation, technical cooperation, South-South cooperation, middle-income countries, ODA in Latin America and internationalization of higher education.



João Falcão e Cunha

is professor at FEUP, the School of Engineering, U.Porto. He has been attending FAUBAI since 2008 after launching in 2005 the MOBILE student exchange programme with Brazilian university engineering schools. He was the Dean of FEUP (2014-22), member of the Supervisory Board of Porto Business School (2014-23) and the Portuguese delegate to the EU Horizon 2020 Committee on Smart, Green and Integrated Transport (2013-18). Previously he was the Director of: Industrial Engineering and Management Master and Doctoral programmes; Service Engineering and Management Master.

is Vice President and Professor Emeritus Michigan State University, Emeritus NAFSA Senior Scholar for Internationalization, and past President of NAFSA and of AIEA. Recipient of awards in internationalization: the EAIE European trans-Atlantic leadership award, the IEAA (Australia) award for distinguished contribution to international education, The AIEA Charles Klasek award for outstanding service to international education, and life membership awarded by NAFSA for distinguished and sustained contribution. He is founding chair of the Center for Higher Education Internationalization academic board at UCSC Milan. He publishes frequently, especially on comprehensive internationalization and the future of internationalization. He is a regularly invited speaker globally.



Thierry Valentin

is Deputy Director General of Campus France. He joined the Embassy of France in Angola (2019-2021), as Cooperation Counsellor. He was Officer for Latin America at the Conference of University Presidents ((2013-2015). He joined the Embassy of France in Brazil (2008-2013), as Director of the CENDOTEC. **Denise Carvalho**

is Secretary of Higher Education at the Brazilian Ministry of Education. She is professor at UFRJ Carlos Chagas Filho Biophysics Institute, and was the first female president of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRJ) (2019-2023). She was also representative of Latin America on the Steering Committee of the Talloires Network of Engaged Universities, regional vice-president of the Inter-American Organization for Higher Education, vice-president of the Regional Conference of Rectors of Latin American Universities and President of the Group for International Cooperation of Brazilian Universities. She has won several awards, such as the Senior Award from the Latin American Thyroid Society (2010) and the Makes a Difference, from the newspaper O Globo.

**Rui Oppermann**

is responsible for International Relations at the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel (CAPES), Ministry of Education in Brazil. He is past President of the Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul (UFRGS) (2016-2020). He is a professor at the Graduate Program in Dentistry - Periodontics at UFRGS. He collaborated in the organization of the Latin American and Caribbean Space of Higher Education (ENLACES) and coordinated the participation of Brazilian Public Institutions of Higher Education in the Regional Conference on Higher Education in Latin America and the Caribbean CRES 2018.



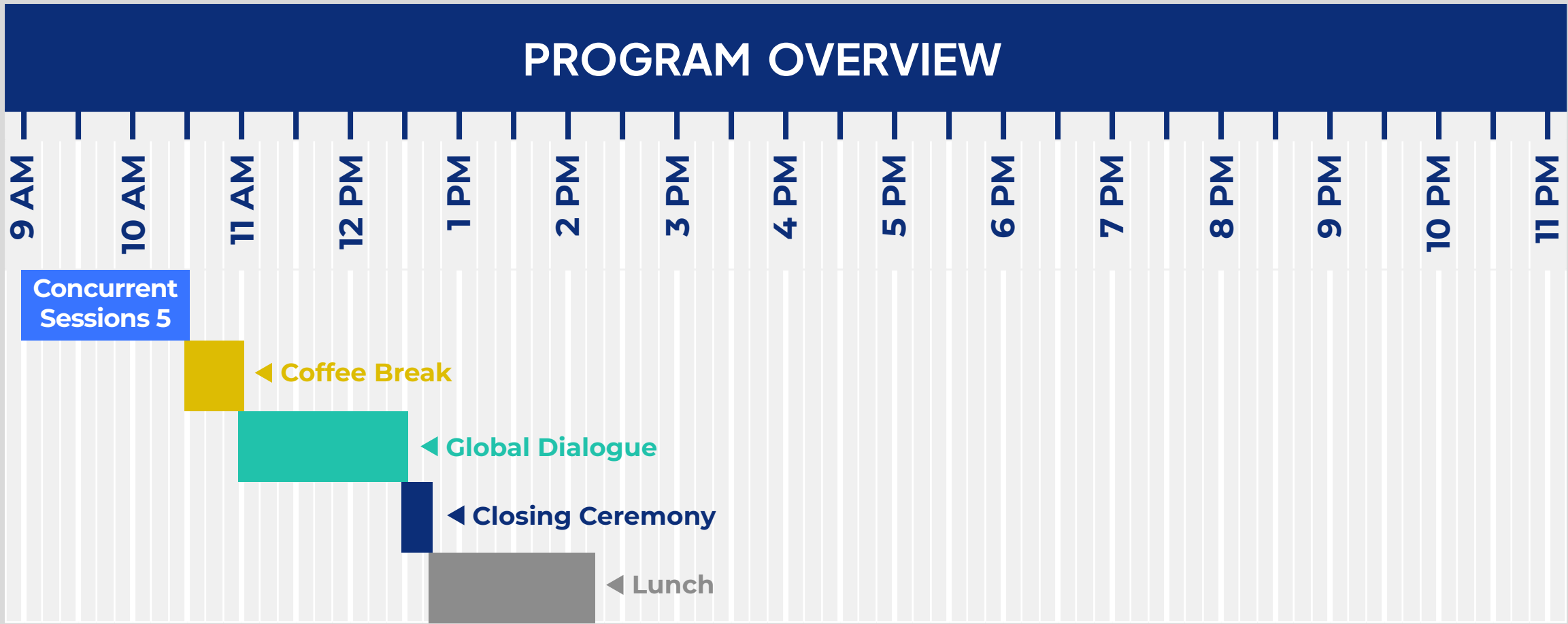
