### The Rise of Intentional & Purposeful of IoHE

- Challenges and perspectives for collaboration for HEI in the south in the "new normal" situation
  - Normal  $\rightarrow$  New Normal?
  - Old models → Urgent Transition → New Models or approaches
  - Global Public Health as an accelerator of the transition
  - Past → Present → Future











### Learn from the past to build the future

#### Old models (-)

- Colonization and brain drain
- Over-partnering
- Over-commercialisation
- Over-traveling
- Over-definitions: lack of definition, clarity in definition?
- Confusion: Internationalization of HE vs IE
- Negative impacts on the leadership, place, management and governance of IHE

#### Old models (+)

- Increase of the number of International students (more revenue = international trade!)
- Brain mobility and circulation
- International research collaboration
- International mobility = more global competencies and awareness
